

Iridium Keyboard Synthesizer – list of fixed bug & new features

ATTENTION: Iridium Keyboard OS versions are not compatible with the Iridium desktop or Quantum. Install only the intended version.

2.8.4 – 2022 – march

Release contains new panel firmware 0.4.
Please update after main firmware update.

Bug Fixes & Improvements:

- Time resolution of pitch bend events sent to external MIDI increased.
- Pitch Bend reacts more tight to incoming events.
- Touch screen plays notes in Note, Scale & Chord screens.
- Info panel shown at boot when wheel calibration is needed.

2.8.3 – 2021

- Factory Headphone Test improved

It has a new feature on the Master->Levels page to switch from poly AT to traditional mono AT. This setting will be stored in the patch and therefore can be individually set per patch.

Otherwise it contains a few bug fixes:

- USB Host port: Improving MIDI output messaging
- Update procedure: Accepting update files from subdirectories
